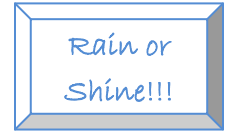

The Minnesota Mounted Shooters is proud to present a new shooters clinic to introduce yourself and your horse to the fast growing sport of Cowboy Mounted Shooting. This clinic will include the introduction to the .45 LC firearm, firearm handling, holsters, tack, ammunition, clothing and some basic rules and regulation. This clinic will also cover some basic horsemanship skills, engaging targets and basic course management. This will be a good opportunity to handle several different types of .45 LC's before you purchase your own. The clinician for this clinic is Leanna Giles. Leanna currently works for the Three Rivers Park Police training and desensitizing horses. She has performed clinics for the Midwest Mounted Patrol, Minnesota Horse Expo several mounted patrol groups around the state as well as many new shooters clinics for the MMSA. Not only does Leanna desensitize horses for a living, she is also a mounted shooter. **Little's performance horses will be donating a pair of bell boots to each paid participant.
