Series Awards:

- Points will be added together with divisional payouts and divisional overall breast collars for Division A (Levels 1 -2), AA (Levels 3 – 4), AAA (Levels 5-6) with NO GENDER SPLIT.
- Wrangler prizes will be based on total wrangler points for all 4 shoots and will be awarded at the end of the series.
- Shotgun results will also be based on the 4 shoots total shotgun points.

Notes:

- Pre-register online at www.cmsaevents.com by midnight the Wednesday prior to each shoot or at www.mncmsa.com by 5:00pm Thursday prior to each shoot to avoid the same day entry fee.
- **You must have a 2012 CMSA competition card to enter this shoot. NO EXCEPTIONS!** Completed membership forms WITH PAYMENT will be taken at the shoot during check-in. Please check-in as early as possible if you are renewing your membership to avoid delaying others. 2012 membership forms are available on the website at www.mncmsa.com.
- All CMSA Rules and MMSA policy apply. If you have not already provided MMSA with a copy of your current negative coggins, please be prepared to provide one upon check in.
- **All riders will need to sign the release form at the shoot when signing in. Any minors whose parents will not be in attendance must bring a signed parental release form with them. This form is available on the website, www.mncmsa.com.**
- Exhibition riders must be entered in the main match, *fees apply with or without ammo*, no exhibition rides will be allowed if we have over 50 entries.
